See below a simplified summary of the requirements for your organisation to establish what is required to achieve and maintain management system certification.



PLAN - Get ready!

- Obtain the relevant ISO/AS management system standard/s
- · Ensure top management (Directors, CEOs, Owners, Senior Management) are ready to lead the process
- · Identify the person/s responsible for the design, development and implementation of the management system
- Understand the needs of internal and external interested parties
- · Identify business/organisation critical processes inputs and outputs
- · Determine and document the scope of the management system
- · Identify objectives
- · Determine process risks and opportunities



DO - Build new, or review existing management systems

- · Create and organise mandatory documentation required by the standard e.g. system scope, policies, objectives
- Define critical process inputs and outputs, know how these interact with each other and be able to monitor their performance
- · Management review and internal audit processes in place
- Train your people in the requirements of your management system
- · Communicate the relevant management system requirements to people in the business
- Take the required actions to address the identified risks and opportunities



CHECK - The beating heart of the management system processes

- · Process performance monitoring
- · Review objectives
- · Management review completed
- · Internal audit program completed



ACT - After attention to the above it's time to take the necessary steps to have your management system ready for the certification process!

- · Make necessary changes to your management system to meet the standard requirements and objectives
- · Plan dates for your initial assessments, confirm these directly with your QMS assessor
